<sup>6</sup> "Your right hand, O LORD, is glorious in power. Your right hand, O LORD, smashes the enemy. <sup>7</sup> In the greatness of your majesty, you overthrow those who rise against you. You unleash your blazing fury; it consumes them like straw.

<sup>11</sup> "Who is like you among the gods, O LORD-- glorious in holiness, awesome in splendor, performing great wonders? <sup>12</sup> You raised your right hand, and the earth swallowed our enemies. <sup>13</sup> "With your unfailing love you lead the people you have redeemed. In your might, you guide them to your sacred home.
